1.	Apologies were received from Cllr B Thornton The Parish Council received the resignation of Cllr N Milnes. RESOLVED: Letter of thanks to be sent.
2.	No NEW Declarations of Interest not already declared under the Council's code of conduct or members Register of Disclosable Pecuniary Interests and consideration of requests for dispensation were received.
3.	Cllr Clark proposed the minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 26th September 2022 be confirmed, seconded Cllr Derry, carried .
4.	<u>Clerk's report to Hartwith cum Winsley Parish Council Meeting 18th October 2022</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Submission made to Google maps to update satellite navigation to show Thomas Gill Road blocked to vehicles beyond Orchard Close.• Area6 NYCC have been contacted to see if there are any objections to the new litter bin at Low Laithe bus shelter being relocated, nor reply has been received to date.• The wild swimmers have expressed their gratitude for the new bench at the weir.• Clarity Arts have signed an agreement with Hartwith cum Winsley Parish Council for the installation of a public access defibrillator at their site on the New York Mills estate.• Following reports of an unpleasant odour around drains at the Poppyfields development, the developers have confirmed that the public sewers have been adopted by Yorkshire Water. If the odour persists, the Parish Council will take the matter up with Yorkshire Water. <i>Cllr Watson reported that Yorkshire Water Dirty Water Unit had visited the site that day to clear the system out.</i>• Micklethwaite Planning Consultancy have requested to attend the next Parish Council meeting to deliver a presentation regarding the proposed development SB5: Land at Braisty Woods, Summerbridge.• A parishioner has contacted the Parish Council to request support for a mirror to be sited at junction of Stripe Lane and the B6165 to provide additional visibility to vehicles exiting into the highway.• The Parish Council noted with sadness the retirement of Revd Mike Poole, Methodist Minister and wished him well for his future endeavours. Cllr Watson attended the farewell service held at Summerbridge Methodist Church on 25th September 2022.

5.	<p><u>Chair's report.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cllr Watson reported that Hesselden's are due to make the final cut for the year. • The Remembrance Service will be held at Summerbridge Methodist Church at 10,15 am on 13th November. It was agreed that Cllrs Watson, Clark, Derry and Benn would attend. The Clerk has ordered two wreaths; one to be laid at the memorial and one to be laid by a member of the parish on the newly installed plaque to those who returned from World War II. • Concerns have been raised about the litter bin in Summerbridge bus shelter. RESOLVED: to be included on the agenda for November.
6.	<p><u>External Reports.</u></p> <p><u>North Yorkshire County Council</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No meetings took place in August and officers are now playing catch-up. • It has been agreed that the new North Yorkshire Council will remain based in County Hall in Northallerton. • North Yorkshire Council has applied for several investment zones, including Harrogate International Centre. • Detailed costs of defibrillator items are required for the locality grant application. • Cllr Hull will grant Locality Funding to the continuation of the Dalesbus service. <p><u>Harrogate Borough Council</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Following receipt of a grant from central government, new air source heat pumps are to be installed at the Hydro in Harrogate and the new Knaresborough sports facilities. Electric vehicle charging points are also being installed at both sites and the gas supply at the Hydro will be withdrawn. Once the refurbishment of the Hydro is complete, the facility will be carbon neutral. • In April 2023 North Yorkshire Council will appoint Charter Trustees to run the un-parished areas of Harrogate.
